Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents treating land in Sy.No.1039 extent of Ac.0.29 gts situated at Gadwal as Waqf land as illegal and contrary to law and consequently direct the respondents not to threaten and dispossess the petitioners from the land in Sy.no.1039 extent of Ac.0.29 gts situated at Gadwal and unless they are restrained.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 to 4 not to interfere and dispossess the petitioners from Sy.No.1039 to an extent of Ac.0.29 gts situated at Gadwal Town, Jogulamba Gadwal District, pending disposal of WP 9873 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri R NARASIMHA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners and GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent Nos.1 & 3 & 4 and Sri M.A. Mujeeb, Advocate for the Respondent No.2, the Court made the following.

**ORDER:**

Though this Court ordered notice before admission on 01.05.2019 and the respondents have entered appearance, no counter affidavit is filed as on

date. Today when the matter is called, there is no representation for the respondents.

Perusal of the material on record shows that the subject lands stands in the names of the petitioners to an extent of Ac.0-15 guntas and Ac.0-14 guntas in Survey No.1039 situated at Gadwal Village and Mandal.

In the circumstances, pending further orders, there shall be interim direction as prayed for.
