Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, directing the 7th Respondent to issue Form-II to the petitioner so as to enable the petitioner to obtain a Contract Labour License under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970. The non issuance of the Form-II which is mandatory by Respondent no. 7 is illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and principles of natural justice;

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to discontinue the work to the employees of the petitioner's society providing outsourcing services to ITDA/ Respondent No.7, from nearly past 10 years, pending disposal of WP No 10672 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of DR.J. VIJAYALAXMI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR LABOUR for the Respondent No.1, GP FOR SOCIAL WELFARE for respondent Nos. 2 & 7 and GP FOR REVENUE for respondent Nos. 3 & 4, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1, 3, 4, 5 and 6 and learned counsel for respondent No.7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the law it is respondent No.7, who is competent authority to issue Form No.II.

However, it is the stand of the learned counsel for respondent No.7 that respondent No.7-entity is not empowered to issue Form No.II. It is submitted that empanelment has to be done by the District Collector-respondent No.3, but the same is done after receiving application from respondent No.7.

The petitioner has submitted various representations to the District Collector-respondent No.3 in this regard.

In the circumstances stated the District Collector-respondent No.3 is directed to consider the representations submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps for empanelment within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, subject to the petitioner fulfilling all other requirements.
