ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner Nos.1 and 2/respondent Nos.1 and 2 seeking to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.06 of 2026 on the file of the learned Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Rajanna Siricilla.

2. Heard Sri Soma Ravi Kiran Reddy, learned counsel representing Sri Boosa Shivachandra, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. When this Court is not inclined to entertain the criminal petition on the ground that specific allegations are levelled against the petitioners and that the grounds raised in the criminal petition require adjudication by the trial Court after a full-fledged trial, at this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to dispense with the presence of the petitioner Nos.1 and 2/respondent Nos.1 and 2 in D.V.C.No.06 of 2026 on the file of the learned Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Rajanna Siricilla.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for petitioners.

5. In view of the above submissions, the presence of the petitioner Nos.1 and 2/respondent Nos.1 and 2 in D.V.C.No.06 of 2026 on the file of the learned Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Rajanna Siricilla, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their

non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
