AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI M.V. PRATAP KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

ORDER:**

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed the alleged offence and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients for the offence under Section 108 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhitha, 2023, are not attracted against the petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioner never instigated or provoked the victim to commit suicide. Hence, the continuation of proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 06.08.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused No.1 in PRC No.3 of 2026 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Choutuppal. In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
