WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI SHYAM S AGRAWAL presented this Petition under 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order quashing the proceedings in the case in Crime No.23/2026 pending before the Pahadi Sheriff Police Station, Rachakonda district, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 324 (4), 329 (3), 126 (2) and 351 (2) read with 3 (5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, against the petitioners/accused No.1 to 3, in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI SHYAM S AGRAWAL Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 07.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order staying all further proceedings in the case in Crime No.23/2026 pending before the Pahadi Sheriff Police Station, Rachakonda district, against the petitioners/accused No.1 to 3, including their appearance, pending disposal of above Criminal Petition, in the interest of justice.

The Court made the following:
ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed the alleged offence and have been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the dispute is purely civil in nature. The petitioners, along with one Smt. Sandhya Gupta, filed a suit vide O.S. No. 20 of 2026, on the file of the learned XII Additional District Judge, Ranga Reddy District, seeking a decree of perpetual injunction restraining respondent No. 2 and others from interfering with the suit schedule property. While the said suit is pending, respondent No. 2 has filed the present complaint, giving it a

criminal colour. Hence, the continuation of proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 07.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 in Crime No.23 of 2026 of Pahadi Sheriff Police Station, Rachakonda District. In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
