ORDER:

This Criminal Petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.2478 of 2024, on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-XI Addl. Judicial Metropolitan Magistrate, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kukatpally.

Mr. S. Surendra Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. B. Venkatesh, learned counsel for respondent No.2, submit that during the

pendency of this criminal petition, at the instance of elders and well wishers, respondent No.2 and the petitioners were entered into compromise and filed I.A.Nos.3 and 4 of 2026 seeking permission to compound the offences and to record the compromise by quashing the proceedings respectively. They further submit that the parties are ready and willing to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee.

In view of the above said submission, the Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the High Court Legal Services Committee immediately.

The petitioners and respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee on 10-04-2026 for their identification.
