WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri GUDI MADHUSUDHAN REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No. 2 in calling the petitioner to the police station and keeping him in the police station every day from early morning hours to evening hours who is suffering with paralasis on the ground that the phone number of the petitioner is mentioned in the registered sale deed vide doc No. 2655/2021 and even though the petitioner is not the accused in crime No. 75/2024 dated 10.2.2024 registered bearing on the complaint made by the respondent No.3 as arbitrary and illegal and nothing but in interfering into the personal life and liberty granted under Article 21 of the constitution of India and consequently to direct the respondent No. 2 not to call the petitioner to the police station and not to interfere into personal life and liberty of the petitioner.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri GUDI MADHUSUDHAN REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOME who takes notice for Respondent No.1 &2 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 03.05.2024 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No. 2 to not to call the petitioner to the police station and not interfere into the personal life and liberty without there being any crime and without following the due process of law, pending disposal of WP No. 9873 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

Issue notice to respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.3 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

There shall be interim direction to respondent No.2 not to interfere with the personal liberty of the petitioner without following due process of law.
