Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any order, direction or Writ, more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the actions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent in issuing Lr.No.TAFRC/03/ Medical/ Dental/ PG/Fee/2023 dated 14.07.2023 pursuant to the Minutes of Meeting dated 10.07.2023 and the consequential G.O.Ms. No. 107 dated 28.07.2023 and G.O.Ms. No. 131 dated 18.03.2023 issued by the 1st respondent as illegal and arbitrary and in violation of the Judgments passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and guidelines/directions issued by this Hon'ble Court apart from violation of fundamental rights and consequently set aside Lr.No.TAFRC/03/ Medical/ Dental/ PG/Fee/2023 dated 14.07.2023 issued pursuant to the Minutes of Meeting dated 10.07.2023 issued by the 3rd Respondent and the consequential G.O.Ms. No. 107 dated 28.07.2023 and G.O.Ms. No. 131 dated 18.08.2023 issued by the 1st Respondent.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondent No. 4 to 7 colleges not to collect the differential fee from the Petitioners and furthermore, direct Respondents No. 4 to 7 to collect fee from the Petitioners herein admitted in 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 academic year falling in the block period of 2023 - 2026 PG Medical Admissions belonging to category - A, @ 60% of the amount payable and for candidates belonging to category - B, @ 70% of the amount payable, as per G.O.Ms.No.107, dated 28.07.2020 & G.O.Ms. No. 131 dated 18.08.2023 issued by the 1st Respondent, pending disposal of WP 9359 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI P. MAHESWAR Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR MEDICAL HEALTH FAMILY WELFARE for the Respondent No.1, SRI T. SHARATH, Standing Counsel for KNR UNIVERSITY for the Respondent No.2 and SRI G. CHANDRASHEKAR, Standing Counsel for TSAFRC, for the Respondent No.3, the Court made the following.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the issue raised in this writ petition is squarely covered by the interim order dated 17.12.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in W.A.Nos.341, 350, 351, 352, 515, 516, 518, 771, 1045, 1047, 1048 and 1049 of 2025; W.P.Nos.6799 and 7455 of 2020; 12347 of 2022; 3896 of 2023; 13895, 15111, 21279, 22859, 24958, 26207, 28690 and 33424 of 2025 and therefore, prayed to pass similar order in this writ petition as well.
