Learned counsel for the petitioner requested this Court to extend the very same protection which was granted by this Court in the batch matters.

Learned Public Prosecutor has not opposed the same.

In view of the order, dated 05.03.2026, passed by this Court in the above said batch, the concerned Police of the District are directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner in the present criminal petition until passing of appropriate orders.
