Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in seeking to dispossess the Petitioners from the private patta land in Sy. No. 90/3 to an extent of 0-37 Gts, Sy. No. 90/1/1 to an extent of 0-11 Gts, Sy. No. 90 to an extent of 0-15 Gts and 0-04 Gts situated at Nagaram village, Vemanpally Mandal, Mancherial District without issuing any notice or opportunity and without following due procedure, as being illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, in violation of principles of natural justice and in violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300A of constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to dispossess the Petitioners from the above said land.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to dispossess the Petitioners from the private patta land in Sy. No.

90/3 to an extent of 0-37 Gts, Sy. No. 90/1/1 to an extent of 0-11 Gts, Sy. No. 90 to an extent of 0-15 Gts & 0-04 Gts situated at Nagaram village, Vemanpally Mandal, Mancherial District pending disposal of the above writ petition pending disposal of WP 9502 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI P LAKSHMA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents and the Court made the following.

ORDER

Mr. L. Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 4, seeks time to get instructions.

Print the name of the learned Standing Counsel for Panchayat Raj.

The petitioners are claiming patta and possession over the subject lands on the strength of e-pattadar pass books bearing Nos.T15180030053, T15180030055 and T15180030004 under Ex.P-1 and Bhu Bharathi extracts under Ex.P-2. Thus, prima facie, the petitioners appear to be owners of the subject lands.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to the respondents' authorities not to interfere with the possession of the petitioners in respect of the lands admeasuring Ac.0-37 guntas in Survey No.90/3, Ac.0-11 guntas in Survey No.90/1/1, Ac.0-15 and Ac.0-04 guntas in Survey No.90 situated at Nagaram Village, Vemanpally Mandal, Mancherial District, without following due process of law.
