S.VIJAYA PRASHANTH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF CERTIORARI, to call for record with regard to impugned order vide proceedings No.E/1384/2025, Dt:17-03-2026 and thereby to set aside the Order vide Proceedings No.E/1384/2025, Dt:17-03-2026 passed by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Achampet & The Presiding Officer of the Tribunal Under the Maintenance Welfare Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007, by cancelling the registered Gift Settlement Deed vide Doc.No. 2106 of 2023 Dt 14-07-2023 with regard to H.No.10-14-23/2/1, Plot No.01 in Block No.9 consists of 52.55 Sq.Yrds situated at Achampet Town and Mandal and Municipality,

Nagarkurnool District executed in favour of the Petitioners, as illegal, invalid and against the principles of natural justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri S VIJAYA PRASHANTH Advocate for the Petitioners and Government Pleader for Revenue for Respondent Nos.1 & 2 AND Asst. Government Pleader for Women Development and Child Welfare and Senior Citizen, for respondent No.3 and directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

There shall be interim stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the letter vide proceedings No.E/1384/2025 dated 17.03.2026 issued by respondent No.3 until further orders.
