Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased toto issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of respondents in releasing the service connections along with electrical meters to the petitioner s property bearing Municipal No. 10-67/3, 10-67/5,

10-67/6, 10-67/10, 10-67/11, 10-67/13, 10-67/17,10-67/22, 10-67/25, 10-67/28, 10-67/29, 10-67/30, 10-67/31, 10-67/32, 10-67/34, 10-67/40, 10-67/41, in Sy No. 84, Situated at Kokapet 3 Village, Rajendra Nagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, covered under registered sale deed vide document bearing No. 1326 of 2004, dated 16.02.2004, on the file of SRO Rajendranagar, and development agreement vide Doc No. 4677/2012, dated 21.09.2012, on the instructions of the 3rd respondent and kept pending the application No. LTM256470222, dated 09.10.2025, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 21 and 300A, against the Letter and spirit of Catena of Judgments rendered by this Honorable Court as well that of Honorable Supreme Court of India apart from being violative of principles of natural Justice and Fair play.

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed with the following prayer:

"... to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of respondents in releasing the service connections along with electrical meters to the petitioner's property bearing Municipal No.10-67/3, 10-67/5, 10-67/6, 10-67/10, 10-67/11, 10-67/13, 10-67/17, 10-67/22, 10-67/25, 10-67/28, 10-67/29, 10-67/30, 10-67/31, 10-67/32, 10-67/34, 10-67/40, 10-67/41 in Sy No.84 Situated at Kokapet 3 Village, Rajendra Nagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, covered under registered sale deed vide document bearing No.1326 of 2004, dated 16.02.2004 on the file of SRO Rajendranagar, and development agreement vide Doc No.4677/2012, dated 21.09.2012 on the instructions of the 3rd respondent and kept pending the application No.LTM256470222, dated 09.10.2025, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 21 and 300A, against the Letter and

spirit of Catena of Judgments rendered by this Honorable Court as well that of Honorable Supreme Court of India apart from being violative of principles of natural Justice and Fair play and pass..."

2. Heard Mr. Mohammed Afzal Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms. S. Jyothi, Assistant Government Pleader for Energy appearing on behalf of the respondent No.1 and Mr. N. Sreedhar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for TGSPDCL appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos.2 to 6. Perused the entire record.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and his wife claim to be the absolute owners and possessors of the agricultural land admeasuring Ac.8.10 guntas in Survey No.84 situated at Kokapet 3 Village, Rajendra Nagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, having purchased the said land under registered sale deeds bearing document Nos.1326 of 2004, dated 16.02.2004 and 4571 of 2004, dated 29.05.2004. They entered into a development agreement and have made an application to the respondents for release of new electricity meter, vide representation dated 09.10.2025. The respondent

authorities have not taken any decision till date about willingness to release the electricity meter.

4. In the circumstances stated, the respondents are under obligation to process the representation of the petitioner dated 09.10.2025 and inform him about its status as to release of electricity meter.

5. In the result, the writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation dated 09.10.2025 submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition, shall stand closed.

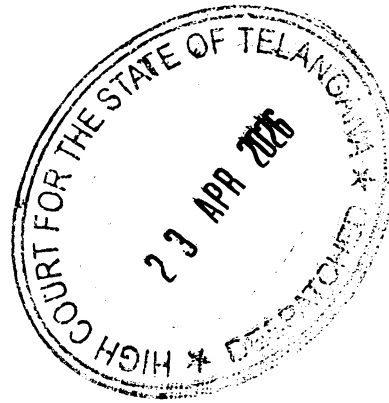
