WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri. CHALAKANI VENKAT YADAV presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, to declare the illegal action of the respondents herein, particularly 5th respondent and his police station authorities, calling the petitioners to the 5th respondent police station, at the instance and influence of the 6th unofficial respondent and official respondents are threatening, blackmailing and interfering with the civil disputes, despite 5th respondent and his authorities neither having any authority, power, nor having any right to call the petitioners to the Police Station, and moreover 5th respondent and his authorities threatening, insisting and directing the petitioners, to settle the alleged civil disputes with the 6th unofficial respondent, pursuant to

the false and fraudulent Agreement of Sale, dated. 21.08.2015, and same has been illegal, arbitrary, unjust, and it's nothing but misuse of their official powers and also pecuniary advantage by abusing their positions as public servants and it's violation of Articles 14, 19, 21, and 300-A of Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents herein, particularly 3rd respondent to 5th respondents herein, not to call the petitioners to the 5th respondent police station and not to interfere with the civil disputes pending between petitioners and 6th unofficial respondent, pursuant to the false and frivolous Agreement of Sale, dated. 21.08.2015; ✓

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri CHALAKANI VENKAT YADAV Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted. ✓

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents herein, more particularly 3rd respondent to 5th respondents not to call the petitioners to the 5th respondent police station 'or' not to interfere with the civil disputes pending between petitioners and 6th unofficial respondent, pursuant to the false and frivolous Agreement of Sale, dated. 21.08.2015 (the said alleged agreement of sale, is non-est in the eye of law and it's nothing but infructuous agreement, it's no longer enforceable, either in law or on facts), in the interest of justice, pending disposal of WP No. 10369 of 2024, on the file of the High Court. ✓

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.6 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing. ✓

Respondent No.5 - the Station House Officer/ the Sub-Inspector of Police, Mallareddigudem (Chinthalapalem) Police Station, is directed not to interfere in the civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.6 in connection with the agreement of sale dated 21.08.2015 without following due process of law. ✓
