In view of the reasons assigned in the accompanying affidavit, the delay of (10) days in resubmitting the Criminal Petition is condoned. Accordingly, this application is ordered. <u>JSR,J</u> <u>CrI.P.No.6165 of 2026</u> This Criminal Petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused seeking to quash the proceedings in S.C.SPL.No.1032 of 2021 on the file of the Sessions Judge for Trial and Disposal of POCSO Act Cases at L.B.Nagar. Heard Mr.B.Krishna Karthik, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.A.Sagar, learned counsel for respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the parties submits that the petitioner and the victim girl performed their marriage as per Hindu Rites and Customs, and the Registrar of Hindu Marriages, L.B. Nagar, Ranga Reddy District, issued a Certificate of Marriage on 07.05.2026. A copy of the said	Transferred to i/o folder, before corrections, if any

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		certificate was filed along with the memo filed vide USR No.67146 of 2026, dated 15.06.2026. They further submit that the petitioner and respondent No. 2, who is none other than the mother of the victim girl, have entered into a compromise and have filed I.A.Nos.4 and 5 of 2026 seeking permission to compound the offences and to record the compromise, respectively. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the petitioner and the daughter of respondent No.2 are living together as husband and wife pursuant to the Certificate of Marriage dated 07.05.2026, and she does not wish to prosecute the proceedings against the petitioner. Taking into consideration the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the marriage certificate produced by the learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner, respondent No.2 and victim girl namely Thobewar Pooja are directed to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee on or before 03.07.2026 for their identification. The Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the High Court Legal Services Committee immediately. The High Court Legal Services Committee shall in turn submit the report before this Court by the next date of hearing. Post on 08.07.2026 under the caption 'for compromise'. _____ JSR, J vsl	

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
