WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI G ESWARAI AH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order, or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.3 in passing orders dated 23.03.2026 in Procs No. L/166/206 directing the 4th respondent to provide police aid and directed the petitioner to vacate the same, without putting the petitioner on notice and without affording of opportunity on hearing to the petitioner illegal, arbitrary and contrary to law, apart from violation of principles of natural justice, besides violation of articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the orders dated 23.03.2026 in Procs No. L/166/206 of the respondent No.3.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI G ESWARAI AH Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
