Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondents in not paying the pension as per last pay drawn even after Hon'ble High Court passed orders to pay arrears in WP No. 26181/2021 as being illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and is contrary to Rule 33 of Pension Rules and violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to pay full pension.
