Learned counsel Sri M.Venkatramana, representing learned
counsel Sri M.Govind Reddy, appears for the petitioner.

2. The writ petition is preferred seeking the following relief:

“For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, the
petitioner herein prays that this Hon’ble Court may be pleased to issue a
writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of

Mandamus declaring the action of the 1st respondent in issuing notification No.28/2020 dated 23-6-2020 perpetually permitting to import Tariff item Maize corn 1005 90 other than seed quality to an extent of 5,00,000 Metric tons @ 15 percent duty/in-quota tariff rate in a financial year as being illegal, arbitrary, bad faith, improper motive, contrary to world trade organisation agreements and in utter violation of principles of natural justice besides unconstitutional and pass such other order or orders in the circumstances of the case.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the writ petition.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
