Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, order or direction, declaring the action of the respondents particularly the action of the 4th respondent in passing Orders on my representation vide Rc.No.Legal/584/2023, dated 9.3.2023 rejecting his representation for granting time scale instead of fixed remuneration as illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction, as the 4th respondent is not competent to reject his representation, as the 2nd respondent alone is the competent authority to pass Speaking Orders on his representation and consequently direct the respondents in to regularise my services as Archaka in the 3rd respondent temple and grant me time scale instead of Consolidated pay as was given to the other similarly situated Archakas as per the dicta laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of Punjab v. Jagjit Singh reported in (2017) 1 SCC 148;

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to regularize his services as Archaka in the 3rd respondent temple and grant him time scale instead of consolidated pay as was given to the other similarly situated Archakas as per the dicta laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of Punjab vs. Jagjit Singh reported in (2017) 1 SCC 148, pending disposal of WP.No.11365 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
