SHIRISHA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a appropriate writ order or direction more particularly a Writ of Mandamus declaring that the order of allotment issued to the petitioners vide Impugned Proceedings Nos.HM/DI/ZVI/PAOP/0044, Dated 29/12/2021 and HM/DI/ZV/PAOP/0001, Dated 10/01/2022, is wholly illegal arbitrary and unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India read with Presidential Order issued vide GOMS.317, dated 06/12/2021 and guidelines issued there under and consequently direct the respondents to allot the petitioner to ZONE VI-charminar as per the preference opted as his new local cadre in terms of the Presidential Order and as per his seniority and preference grounds taking into the present cadre as per the G O Ms No.317 including direction to direct the Respondents to consider the petitioner appeal against allocation of new cadre for allotment of Petitioner to ZONE VI-Charminar as his new local cadre.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. B. SHIRISHA Advocate for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III, who accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-II, who accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
