Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the proceedings of the Respondent No.2 in F.No.V-11015/48/ /2011/7094 dat14.09.2011 consequently the petitioner herein has preferred an appeal before the Respondent No. 3 and the appeal was dismissed bearing proceedings no. V-15014/LandR/SS/Rev./BK/2011- 09 dated 05.01.2012 without providing an opportunity of the petitioners version as confirmed by the 2d Respondent as illegal, arbitrary, without application of mind and violation of principles of natural justice consequently direct the Respondents to reconsider the representations made by the petitioner dated 01.04.2012 and pass such other or further order or orders as this Honble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case, in the interest of justice.

WRIT PETITION No.21614 OF 2015

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed to declare the proceedings of respondent No.2 in F.No.V-11015/48/___/2011/7094 dated 14.09.2011. Consequently, the petitioner has filed an appeal before respondent No.3 and the same was dismissed bearing proceedings No.V-15014/L&R/SS/Rev./BK/2011-09 dated 05.01.2012 without providing an opportunity of petitioners version as confirmed by respondent No.2 and direct the respondents to reconsider the representations made by petitioner dated 01.04.2012.

2. Heard Mr.GRS-Akhileshwar, Deputy Solicitor General of India.

3. The petitioner herein was removed from the service, as such he preferred an appeal before the Central Administrative Tribunal and the Tribunal returned the same, as such, he filed the present Writ Petition.

4. Perusal of the docket proceedings shows that on 20.01.2025 the matter was directed to be listed under the caption 'for dismissal' on 27.01.2025. Today also there is no representation for the petitioner.

5. Petitioner was a Constable in Central Industrial Security Force (CSIF Unit)/RSTPS, Ramagundam, Telangana. As he preferred an appeal and the same was rejected, he filed the present writ petition, but he did not turn up. Therefore, this Court finds that no purpose would be served in continuing the present petition and is liable to be dismissed.

6. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed. No order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.

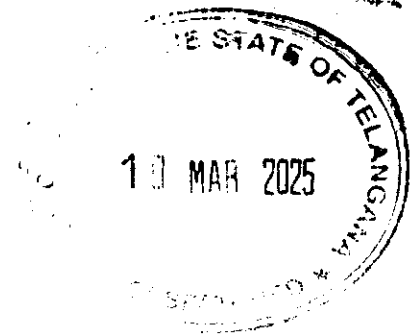
