WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri C RAJA SEKHAR REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction .

- (i) Declaring the impugned Proceedings bearing Rc.No. A7/4273/2009 dated 23.03.2018 issued by Respondent No. 3 directing the termination of the service of the Petitioners and limiting the arrears of salaries payable to them only up to 30.04.2012, as being illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, in violation of the principles of natural justice and in violation of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently to set aside the same;
- (ii) Consequently, set aside the termination proceedings bearing proceedings in Rc.No. A/483/2021, dt.03-08-2021 of the Respondent No. 4.
- (iii) Consequently, to direct the Respondents to continue the Petitioners in the post of Village Revenue Assistant where they were working earlier, or any other post to which other individuals working as Village Revenue Assistant may be absorbed, with all consequential benefits and also to direct the

respondents to pay arrears of salary / honorarium and other service benefits from 25.04.2012 to till date.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri C Raja Sekhar Reddy Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
