	05.05.2026	<u>KL,J & BRMR,J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> This application is filed seeking interim custody of the minor children to the petitioner - husband. Respondent - wife has filed an application <i>vide</i> O.P.No.1203 of 2021 under Sections 7 and 10 of the Guardians and Wards Act and Section 7(g) of the Family Courts Act, seeking permanent custody of the children i.e, Mohammed Jasir Farzaan, aged about 12 years and Farah Maryam Jaffer, aged about 8 years, to retain their custody. Appellant – husband has filed counter claim in the said O.P. <i>Vide</i> order dated 16.02.2026, learned Family Court dismissed the counter claim filed by the appellant – husband and allowed the O.P filed by the respondent – wife. Challenging the said order, appellant – husband preferred FCA.No.54 of 2026. Perusal of the record would reveal that appellant - husband has filed a memo dated 25.04.2025 in I.A.No.344 of 2024 in O.P.No.1203 of 2021 and contended that he has received mail from the respondent – wife consenting interim custody of the kids from 27.04.2024 evening 06.00 p.m., till 05.05.2024 06.00 p.m.	

		In the counter filed by the respondent – wife in the present I.A., at paragraph No.6, she has given consent to the children to stay with the petitioner - husband for five days i.e., from 29.04.2026 to 05.05.2026. During the course of hearing, it is brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner – husband is working in private company, he is an Engineer, he has to apply leave and take the children for excursion. In the light of the same, this application is disposed of granting interim custody of the children i.e., Mohammed Jasir Farzaan, aged about 12 years and Farah Maryam Jaffer, aged about 8 years to the petitioner – father from 15.05.2026 to 25.05.2026. Petitioner take the children from the custody of the respondent on 15.05.2026 at 10.00 a.m., and hand over them to the respondent on 26.05.2026 at 10.00 a.m. Both the appellant – husband and respondent – wife shall cooperate with each other in compliance of this order. <u>FCA.No.54 of 2026</u> List on 07.07.2026.
