Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ Order or orders more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the impugned Proc. No. ES/ES/MA/WANA/SCAS/0053, dated. 21.12.2021 issued by the 1st respondent allotting the petitioner to Wanaparthi District contrary to the option exercised to Mahabubnagar District not extending the benefit under preferential category of Widow as per the G.O.Ms.317 Dt. 06.12.2021 by discriminating among the widows is totally unjustified, unlawful and inhumane and consequently declare that I am entitled for posting and retaining/re-allotting to Mahabubnagar District under preferential category of Widow with all consequential benefits.

ORDER

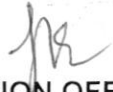
There shall be interim direction to respondent No.5 to dispose of the appeal dated 30.03.2022 filed by the petitioner, by duly taking into consideration the
