WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI G DINESH PATIL presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any appropriate writ, order or directions more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus for declaring action on the part of the respondent No. 4 and 5 in not conducting fair investigation and not take proper steps to remand the unofficial respondents in cognizable offences viz offence punishable under section 109 read with section 3(5) of B.N.S. in pursuant to FIR 2193/2025 dated. 14/11/2025 is wholly illegal, highly arbitrary, unconstitutional, bad in law and against the provision of article 14, 15 and 21 of Constitution of India and Section 173 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (corresponding to old Section 154 of Cr.P.C.) and against the principles laid down in Lalitha Kumaris case and against the principles of natural justice AND direct the respondent No.2 and 3 to transfer or

entrust to senior and independent officer outside of Narisngi Police Station to conduct fair and impartial investigation in pursuant to crime No. 2193/2025 and duly followed the procedure and guidelines of Supreme Court;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. G DINESH PATIL Advocate for the Petitioner, AGP FOR HOME for respondent Nos. 1 to 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 6 & 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to interim direction to the respondent No. 2 and 3 to transfer or entrust to senior and independent officer outside of Narisngi Police Station to conduct fair and impartial investigation in pursuant to crime No. 2193/2025 and duly followed the procedure and guidelines of Supreme Court, pending disposal of WP No 11061 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 and waives further notice. He seeks time to obtain instructions and make submissions.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.6 and 7.

Personal notice is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that basing on the complaint filed by the petitioner, F.I.R.No.2193 of 2025 is registered against unofficial respondent Nos.6 and 7 on the file of the Station House Officer, P.S. Narsingi, Cyberabad District for the offences punishable under Sections 109 r/w 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023; that though the offence under Section 109 of BNS is cognizable in nature, respondent Nos.4 and 5 are not conducting the

investigation in fair manner and not taking steps to remand unofficial respondent Nos.6 and 7 to custody, which is against the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Lalitha Kumari Vs. Government of Uttar Pradesh¹. Therefore, he seeks to pass appropriate orders.

This matter requires detailed examination.

The facts can only be ascertained after filing counter by respondents.

Till such time, official respondent Nos.4 and 5 are directed to file a detailed report on the status of investigation being conducted in F.I.R.No.2193 of 2025 before the Station House Officer, P.S. Narsingi, Cyberabad District.
