WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri MOHAMMED ADAM presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No. 5 in interfering in a civil dispute between the Petitioner and Respondent No. 6 as illegal, arbitrary, unlawful and exceeding the powers vested on him and consequently direct the Respondent Nos. 3 and 5 not to interfere in the civil dispute and not to pressurize the Petitioner to handover the physical possession of Flat No. 301, Akhurath Nivas, Plot No. 81, Gopala Krishna Puram, Bandlaguda, Nagole, Medchal Malkajgiri District, and to settle the civil dispute with the Petitioner and Respondent No. 6.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. MOHAMMED ADAM Advocate for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, who takes notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue notice to Respondent No.5, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 17.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass an interim direction thereby directing, the Respondents No. 3 and 5 not to call the Petitioner to police station illegally and not to harass, humiliate, and pressurize the Petitioner to handover the physical possession of Flat No. 301, Akhurath Nivas, Plot No. 81, Gopala Krishna Puram, Bandlaguda, Nagole, Medhchal Malkajgiri District, pending disposal of WP.No.11303 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 4 and waives further notice and seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.5 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Mr. Krupachand Gogineni, learned counsel submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of respondent No.6 and seeks time to file vakalat.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.5 who has been working as Circle Inspector of Police, Nagole Police Station, in personal capacity, at the behest of respondent No.6 had been interfering into the *inter se* private disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.6 without following due process of law.

This matter required detailed examination and the facts of the case can only be ascertained after filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

In the meanwhile, as an interim measure, respondent No.4 is directed not to interfere with the *inter se* civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.6, except under due process of law.
