WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. Y SHASHIDHAR REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ or Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents, more particularly Respondent No.5 AND 6, threatening the petitioner for withdrawal of the Civil Suit in O.S. No.57 of 2024 pending on the file of the Learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Kollapur, Nagarkurnool District and C.M.A. No.6 of 2025 (Ad-interim Injunction Order passed in I.A. No.374 of 2025) on the file of the Learned

Principal District Judge, Nagarkurnool, thereby unlawfully interfering in civil disputes at the instance of respondent no.7 are wholly illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, and violative of the principles of natural justice, and are in clear infringement of the fundamental rights guaranteed under Articles 19 and 21, as well as the constitutional right under Article 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent no. 5 AND 6 not to threaten, coerce, or harass the petitioner, including by frequently summoning the petitioner to the police station or compelling the petitioner withdraw the civil proceedings, namely I.A. No.116 of 2024 in O.S. No.57 of 2024 pending on the file of the Learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Kollapur, and I.A. No.374 of 2025 in C.M.A. No.6 of 2025 pending on the file of the Learned Principal District Judge, Nagar Kurnool, and not to interfere in the pending civil disputes in any manner whatsoever.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. Y SHASHIDHAR REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOMES, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 6, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 17.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondent Nos.5 and 6, pending disposal of the present Writ Petition, not to threaten, coerce, or harass the petitioner, including by frequently summoning the petitioner to the police station, or compelling the petitioner to withdraw the civil proceedings, namely LA_ No_116 of 2024 in O.S. No.57 of 2024 pending on the file of the Learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Kollapur. and I.A. No.374 of 2025 in C.M.A. No.6 of 2025 pending on the file of the Learned Principal District Judge, Nagar Kurnool.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 6 and waives further notice and seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to respondent No.7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.7 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that admittedly there are civil disputes pending between the petitioner and unofficial respondent in O.S.No.57 of 2024 on the file of I Additional Junior Civil Judge, at Kollapur and an ad-interim injunction has been granted in favour of the petitioner in I.A.No.116 of 2024 in O.S.No.57 of 2024. Despite the said fact, at the behest of unofficial respondent, respondent Nos.5 and 6 are exerting pressure upon the petitioner herein to settle the *inter se* private disputes between the petitioner and unofficial respondent without following due process of law.

This matter required detailed examination and the facts of the case can only be ascertained after filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

In the meanwhile, as an interim measure, respondent Nos.5 and 6 are directed not to interfere with the *inter se* civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.7, except under due process of law.
