Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order, or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent authorities, particularly 5th respondent in not issuing new pattadar passbooks to the petitioners, except 1st petitioner, and claiming to have initiated steps to resume the lands of all the petitioners in which they are in continuous possession and enjoyment, in violation of procedures established under the law, against the stated public policy and principles of natural justice as illegal, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondent authorities not to interfere in any manner with the possession, enjoyment and patta rights over the subject lands in various subdivisions of Sy.Nos.1411 of Andole village and mandal, Sangareddy District, except in accordance with law.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to take any kind of coercive steps against the petitioners over the subject lands in various sub-divisions of Sy.Nos.1411 of Andole village and mandal, Sangareddy District, pending disposal of WP.No.14110 of 2020, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2020

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 5th respondent to immediately act upon the representation of the petitioners dt: 27.07.2020 for the issuance of new pattadar passbooks and granting of Rythu Bandhu benefits, with regard to the subject lands in various subdivisions of Sy.Nos.1411 of Andole village and mandal, Sangareddy District, pending disposal of WP.No.14110 of 2020, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s CH RAVI KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioners and GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents, the Court made the following.
