Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction or writ, more particularly one in nature of writ of mandamus declare the impugned action of the respondents in not releasing and paying the retirement benefits, such as Gratuity (TS) an amount of Rs.3,94,259/- with token No.2601101155 date 20.08.2025, Gratuity (CS)an amount of Rs.12,05,741/-with token No. 2601101157 date 20.08.2025, Commutation (TS) an

amount of Rs.5,65,861 /- with token No. 2601101159 date 20.08.2025, Commutation (CS) an amount of Rs. 17,30,544/- with token No,2601101158 date 20.08.2025, GPF Final payment an amount of Rs.8,90,325/-with token/Cheque No. 2600510670 Date 10.06.2025, Final EL/HPL amount of Rs.12,20,848/-with token No.2600510491 Date 10.06.2025, GIS an amount of Rs. 72,600/-with token No. 2600510681 date 10.06.2025, PRC an amount of Rs. 3,04,576/- vide first token No,2600510632 date 10.06.2025 along with 11 token Numbers of the same date and DA Arrears of Final ELs and HPL 1st Instalment an amount of Rs.33,131/- with token No. 2601315169 date 12.09.2025 and 2nd Instalment an amount of Rs.33,140/- with token No. 2603813632 date 23.03.2026 etc is illegal, unfair, unjust and violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300(A) of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to release the said benefits together with interest @ 24 PERCENT PA on belated payments.

ORDER:

Heard Sri Y.Ravi Prakash, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III appearing for the respondents and perused the material on record. With their consent, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner filed the instant Writ Petition questioning the action of the respondents in not releasing the petitioner's retiral

benefits, despite token numbers having already been raised by the respondent authorities for payment of the amounts payable to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the *lis* raised in the present Writ Petition has already been adjudicated by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P.No.23138 of 2025, which was disposed of *vide* order dated 03.09.2025, and thus prayed to pass a similar order in the present Writ Petition also.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III did not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner with regard to the disposal of W.P.No.23138 of 2025 dated 03.09.2025 and submits that the respondents will release the amounts on a priority basis of the token numbers and prayed this Court to pass appropriate orders.

5. Having regard to the above made submissions and for the reasons alike in the order dated 03.09.2025 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P.No.23138 of 2025, this Writ

Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to ensure that the entire amount payable to the petitioner is released as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six (6) weeks from today, failing which, the entire amount with regard to the retiral benefits shall carry interest at the rate of 10% per annum, from the date the amount fell due, till the actual date of its payment.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

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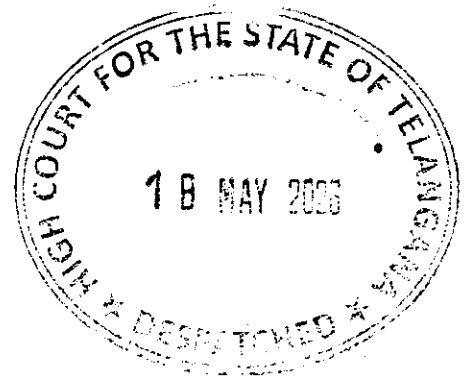
