WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI M A SHAKEEL presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents particularly Respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and 9 in harassing the petitioner and his family members under the guise of family counseling in matrimonial dispute in between petitioner and 7th Respondent and repeatedly calling and summoning petitioner and his other family members to the police station and compelling to join with the 7th

Respondent and further interfering with the petitioner's personal life and liberty and marital independence and threatening the petitioner and his family members with criminal prosecution in the event of non-cooperation and also in action of the Respondents in taking action against Respondent Nos.8 and 9 for their illegal interference in the personal life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members abuse of official position as being illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, violative of Muslim Personal Law, abuse of police powers and unconstitutional being violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondents not to interfere in the matrimonial dispute except in accordance with due process of law and further direct the police authorities to provide protection to the petitioner and his family members from the threats of Respondent Nos.8 and 9 by directing to initiate appropriate action for criminal intimidation and misuse of power and further direct Respondents 2 and 3 to initiate an inquiry into the illegal acts of police officials and misuse of police machinery at the behest and influence of Respondents 7 to 9 and take action in accordance with law;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. M A SHAKÉEL Advocate for the Petitioner, AGP FOR HOME for respondent Nos. 1 to 6, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 7 to 9, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to interfere in the matrimonial dispute as well as not to take any coercive action except in accordance with due process of law, pending disposal of WP No 11052 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:
ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 6 and waives further notice. He seeks time to obtain instructions and make submissions.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.7 to 9.

Personal notice is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the unofficial respondent No.7 is the lawfully wedded wife of the petitioner and respondent Nos.8 and 9 are her relatives. He contends that and there were matrimonial disputes between petitioner and respondent No.7. While so, respondent Nos.4 to 6, at the behest of respondent No.9 are harassing the petitioner by calling him to the Police Station and exerting pressure upon him to settle the subsisting matrimonial disputes, without following the due process of law. Therefore, he seeks to pass appropriate orders.

This matter requires detailed examination.

The facts can only be ascertained after filing counter by respondents.

Till such time, official respondent Nos.4 to 6 are directed not to interfere with the matrimonial disputes between the petitioner and respondent No.7 except by following the procedure contemplated under law.
