Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents no. 2 to 4 to allow the Petitioners to attend their Semester examinations and reconduct the examination which they have missed as expeditiously as possible Pending disposal of WP No. 11167 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

This Interlocutory Application is filed by the petitioners seeking a direction to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 to permit them to attend their respective semester examinations and to reconduct the examinations, which they have missed, as expeditiously as possible.

Heard Sri Ponnam Ashok Goud, learned counsel representing Sri Ponnam Mahesh Goud, learned counsel for the petitioners. Perused the material available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were placed under suspension in connection with the unfortunate suicide of one Ms. P. Srividya, who was roommate of the petitioners, without issuance of any notice, without conducting a proper enquiry, without assigning any reasons, and without furnishing a copy of the Committee report. It is contended that such action is in clear violation of the principles of natural justice. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no role whatsoever in the said incident, which occurred at the residence of Ms. P. Srividya. It is also contended that the petitioners are being prevented from attending their ongoing semester examinations, which would seriously prejudice their academic careers. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the examinations of the petitioner No.1 commenced from 07.04.2026, and the examinations of the remaining petitioners are scheduled to commence from 20.04.2026. Hence, the learned counsel sought for a direction to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 to permit the petitioners to attend their respective examinations and to reconduct the examinations, if any, already missed by them, as expeditiously as possible.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and upon consideration of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is of the prima facie view that the matter requires detailed examination.

Accordingly, there shall be an interim direction to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 to permit the petitioners to attend their respective semester examinations. The respondents are further directed to reconduct the examinations, if any, already missed by the petitioners, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
