WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/S. SATYA SADHAN CHALAMALA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of Respondent No.2 in freezing the Petitioner's Savings Bank Account bearing No. 142101501102 maintained with ICICI Bank, Banjara Hills Branch, Hyderabad, instead of restricting the alleged disputed amount by way of lien pursuant to the directions of Respondent No.3 - Police, as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of Sections 106 and 107 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, as well as Articles 14 and 300A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct Respondent No.2 to forthwith de-freeze the said account and restore full operational access to the Petitioner, enabling normal banking transactions.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. SATYA SADHAN CHALAMALA Advocate for the Petitioner and SRI N. BHUJANGA RAO, DEPUTY SOLICITOR GENERAL OF INDIA appearing for the Respondent no.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondents no. 2 and 3 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

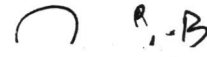
