WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI. RAPOLU BHASKAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.4 in issuing the Proceedings through vide No.F.NO.ECIR/HYZO/23/2022/911 on 14.05.2025 and kept the House property of the Petitioners through vide House bearing No.8-7-94/83, Plot No.83, Survey No.59 Part, New Survey No.59/1, admeasuring 416 Sq. Yards, which is situated at Road No.5, Karmanghat Village, Saroornagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District under the

prohibited property is illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violation of Articles 14, 15, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and also violation of Principles of Natural Justice and set aside the Proceeding No. F. No.ECIR/HYZO/23/2022/911 on 17.5.25 and consequently direct the R4 to delete the house property at the Petitioners from the Prohibited property through vide House bearing No.8-7-94/83, Plot No.83, Survey No.59 Part, New Survey No.59/1, admeasuring 416 Sq. Yards, which is situated at Road No 5 Karmanghat Village, Saroornagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. RAPOLU BHASKAR Advocate for the Petitioners, Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, 6 and 7 and Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue on behalf of respondent No 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
