1.	10.04.2026	<u>SKS,J</u> <u>CRL.R.C.No.382 of 2026</u> List this case on 30.06.2026. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Dispensed with for the present. <u>I.A.No.2 of 2026</u> This application is filed seeking to suspend the impugned judgment dated 03.03.2026 passed in CrI.A.No.2 of 2025 by the learned Principal Sessions Judge at Kamareddy, whereby and where of the judgment dated 24.07.2024 passed in S.C.No.5 of 2024 by the learned Assistant Sessions Judge, Kamareddy. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was convicted for the offence under Section 498-A and 307 of the IPC and under Section 235(2) Cr.P.C. and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of five years under Section 307 of the IPC and for a period of one year under Section 498-A and the same was modified by the appellate Court by confirming the conviction in CrI.A.No.2 of 2025 and reduced the sentence from five years to two years under Section 307 of IPC. It is further submitted that though there is no evidence on record to prove the guilt of the petitioner, both the Courts erroneously convicted the petitioner and that there are good grounds to succeed in the revision petition, as such

		requested to allow the present petition. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the same stating that there is no illegality in the judgment by the Courts below and there are no merits in the petition. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel on either side, and a perusal of the material available on record, it appears that the petitioner has made good grounds to succeed in the appeal. Considering the same, there shall be interim suspension of the sentence alone imposed by the appellate Court till the disposal of the criminal revision case, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall execute a personal bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for a likesum each to the satisfaction of learned Assistant Sessions Judge at Kamareddy.
