Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents, particularly the Respondent No. 5, in opening, maintaining and continuing the Rowdy Sheet against the petitioner as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and also contrary to the Standing Orders of AP Police Manual, governing the opening and continuation of Rowdy Sheet, and consequently quash the Rowdy Sheet maintained by the respondent no 5, vide Proceedings No. 165/OW/ACP-STN/2010 Dated. 05-05-2010 against the petitioner in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.5 not to summon the petitioner to the Police Station or interfere with the personal liberty and livelihood of the petitioner under the guise of the Rowdy Sheet, pending disposal of WP No 11105 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI MOHD MANZOOR NAYEEM Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR HOME appears for the Respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner would not fall within the zone of consideration under Standing Order No.601, of A.P. Police Manual, Part-I, Volume-II. Despite, the official respondents are exerting pressure upon the petitioner and interfering with the personal life and liberty of the petitioner on the pretext of a rowdy sheet maintained by respondent No.5. Therefore, he seeks to pass appropriate orders.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home seeks time to obtain instructions and make submissions.

This matter requires detailed examination.

The facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions or counter affidavit by respondents.

In the meanwhile, as an interim measure, the official respondents are directed not to interfere with the personal life and liberty of the petitioner except by following the procedure contemplated under law.
