Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent No. 4 in interfering with civil disputes and supporting the illegal dispossession attempts by Respondent No. 4 and calling me to police station for settlement with-out serving notice or affording me a fair opportunity to be heard as illegal and arbitrary.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent police more particularly the Respondent No. 4 not to interfere into civil disputes without following the due process of law.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P N Dayakar Advocate for the Petitioner (being not present), GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent No.4, the Court made the following.

ORDER

None appears for the petitioner.

Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent No.4 submitted that a complaint has been given by respondent No.4 against the petitioner and the same has already been registered as a crime vide FIR No.717 of 2026, dated 12.05.2026.

It is further submitted that an interim order was granted by this Court on 13.04.2026, directing respondent No.3 not to interfere with the civil disputes pending between the petitioner and respondent No.4 without following due process of law. He submitted that in the guise of the said order, the police are not investigating the FIR No.717 of 2026. He therefore prayed for a direction to the police to conduct investigation pursuant to FIR No.717 of 2026.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home submitted that pursuant to the interim directions of this Court, the police are not interfering in the civil disputes.

However, this Court finds that after the interim directions of this Court on 13.04.2026 only the FIR No.717 of 2026, dated 12.05.2026, has been registered. Therefore, it is clarified and the respondents No.1 to 3 are directed to proceed with the investigation in respect of the FIR No.717 of 2026, dated 12.05.2026 strictly in accordance with law.
