WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI G ARUN KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents 2 to 5 in not taking any action on my representation dated 01.04.2026 against Respondents 6 and 7, who are constructing the room without permission on part of Petitioner's land by encroaching about 10 feet on northern side of main road bearing H.No.3-144, Mogullapally Village and Mandal, Jayasanker Bhupalapally District and also 5 feet

road margin, is illegal, arbitrary, violation of Articles 14 and 300-A of the Constitution of India besides in violation of Telangana State Panchayat Raj Act and Rules made therein and consequently direct the Respondents 2 to 5 to consider the representation dated 01.04.2026 of the petitioner and to demolish the unauthorized construction on part of petitioner's land about 10 feet on northern side of main road bearing H.No.3-144, Mogullapally Village and Mandal, Jayasanker Bhupalapally District and also road margin 5 feet encroached by Respondents 6 and 7.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. G ARUN KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR PANCHAYAT RAJ, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 5 and directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 6 & 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 22.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Issue notice to the respondent Nos.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is also permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent Nos.6 and 7 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and to file proof of service.

Learned Assistant Government Pleaders, representing learned Government Pleaders for Panchayat Raj and Rural Development and revenue and also learned standing counsel for respondent No.5 seek time.

Since it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that, despite the petitioner's representation dated 01.04.2026 against respondent Nos.6 and 7 alleging illegal construction of a room on the petitioner's land by encroaching about 10 feet on the northern side of the main road bearing H.No.3-144, Mogullapally Village and Mandal, Jayashankar Bhupalpally and also encroaching 5 feet of the road margin, the official respondents have not

taken any action, this Court is of the opinion that the said aspect requires detailed examination based on the assertions to be made by the respondents in their counters.

The respondent Nos.4 and 5 shall obtain instructions on the aspect of the status of the representation of the petitioner dated 01.04.2026 by the next date.
