The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard Mr. Mr. Mohana Sai Baba Guniseti, learned counsel, representing Mr. R.Chandrashekar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners; Mr. L.Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for respondents No.1 to 3; Mr. Putta Krishna Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.4; Mr. R.Sameer Ahmed, learned Standing Counsel for HYDRAA, appearing for respondent No.5; and Mr. Mahesh Raje, learned Government Pleader, appearing for respondents No.6 and 7.

As seen from the record, no document relating to title or possession of the petitioners in respect of the property bearing H.Nos.4-88/A, 4-134, 3-11/A, 2-53/A, 1-218/1, 1-162, 4-03, 1-262, 4-17, 4-14, 1-28, 1-24 in Survey No.119, situated at Ilapur Thanda, Ameenpur Mandal, Sanga Reddy District, is filed. The photographs filed along with the writ affidavit (Ex.P-1) show that there are structures made in the subject property and major part of the land appears to be vacant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that huge force of respondent No.5-HYDRAA personnel high-handedly entered into the subject property with Bulldozers and JCB machines and started demolition and necked out the petitioners from the property. As such, necessary documents could not be filed and the same would be filed at later point of time.

Learned Standing Counsel for HYDRAA, appearing for respondent No.5, basing on the written instructions, submitted that no structure whatsoever existing in the subject property has been demolished and assured that the structures in Survey No.119 will not be demolished without following due process of law. It is further submitted that respondent No.5 is taking action in compliance of the order dated 14.06.2024 passed by this Court in W.P. No.10723 of 2024 filed by Mr. S.K.Baazi and others, and as per requisition given by the Revenue Department for protection of the subject property therein. Learned Standing Counsel submitted that W.P. No.9460 of 2025 was filed with similar claim seeking for electricity connection for the property in Survey No.119 and 121 of Ilapur Thanda and the same was dismissed by the order passed by this Court dated 30.07.2025. The said order was challenged in W.A.No.1115 of 2025 and the order dated 24.02.2026 was passed dismissing the said appeal. It is contended that the writ petition and the appeal were dismissed as the petitioners therein failed to establish any title or possession over the lands in Survey No.119 and 121 as mentioned therein. Learned Standing Counsel further submitted that respondent No.5 is only protecting the vacant land in Survey No.119 belonging to the Government by duly fencing it to prevent encroachments as per requisition of the Revenue Department.

Learned Government Pleader for Home, appearing for respondents No.6 and 7, submitted that Police aid was given to respondent No.5-HYDRAA on their requisition dated 10.04.2026 to ensure that there is smooth and safe execution of the programme under taken by respondent No.5.

In the circumstances, status quo obtaining as on today shall be maintained only to the extent of the structures standing in Survey No.119, situated at Ilapur Thanda, Ameenpur Mandal, Sanga Reddy District, till the next date of hearing.

This order, however, shall not come in the way of the respondent authorities in taking action against the petitioners by following due process of law.

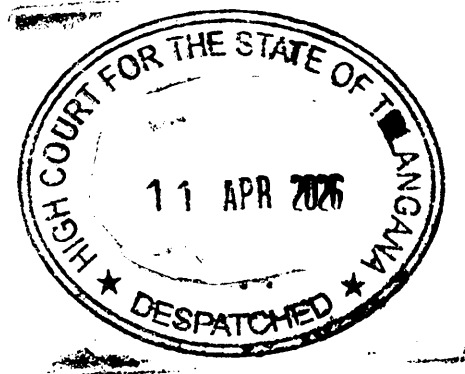
