WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI P SHIVA REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or order/s more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No. 2 and 3, in trying to give possession to the respondent Nos. 5 and 6 inspite of pending civil suit for perpetual injunction in OS No. 110 of 2025 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge Vikarabad district at Parigi, as being illegal arbitrary and violative of Articles 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 not to interfere in civil matters and not to dispossess the petitioners over the subject land situated at Ramnagar village, Kulkacharala Mandal, Vikarabad district and be pleased to pass

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI. P SHIVA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner and Assistant Government Pleader for Home for the respondent Nos.1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.4 to 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to issue interim directions to the respondent Nos. 2 and 3, not to interfere in civil matters, pending disposal of WP No 11385 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following:
ORDER**

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3 and waives further notice and seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.4 to 6 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that admittedly there are civil disputes pending between the petitioners and unofficial respondents in O.S.No.110 of 2025 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge, at Pargi, Vikarabad District. Despite the said fact, at the behest of unofficial respondents, respondent No.3 is exerting pressure upon the petitioners herein to settle the inter se private disputes between the petitioners and unofficial respondents without following due process of law.

This matter required detailed examination and the facts of the case can only be ascertained after filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

In the meanwhile, as an interim measure, respondent No.3 is directed not to interfere with the inter se civil disputes pending between the petitioner and unofficial respondents, except under due process of law.
