WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI SHASHANK GARIGE presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order, or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondents 2 and 3 in interfere with the family dispute between the petitioners and 4th respondent and not to call the petitioners to the police station based on a false complaint filed by the 4th respondent and without registering any crime against the petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary and violation of fundamental rights as enshrined under the Constitution and also violation of the principles of right to life and liberty.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI SHASHANK GARIGE Advocate for the Petitioners and SRI M. SRINIVAS, AGP FOR HOME appears for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 30.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent 2 and 3 not to call the petitioners to the police without there being any FIR registered against the petitioners and not to pressure the petitioner to compromise the family dispute by paying money, pending disposal of WP No 12366 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Mr. M. Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, takes notice for respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice and seeks time to get instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.4 through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of the same by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that without issuing any notice and without registering a crime against the petitioners, at the behest of respondent No.4, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are interfering with the disputes between petitioners and respondent No.4 and frequently calling them to the police station and pressuring to settle the disputes with respondent No.4.

This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter by the official respondents.

In the meantime, respondent No.4 is directed not to interfere with the *inter se* civil disputes between the petitioners and respondent No.4 without following due process of law.
