ORDER:

Mr. K. Devanath, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that accused No.3 has approached this Court and filed CrI.P.No.6254 of 2025, seeking to quash the very same proceedings against them in C.C.No.2298 of 2024 and this Court on 30.03.2026, allowed the said criminal petition, quashing the proceedings against accused No.3 on the ground that the Investigating Officer without obtaining permission from the competent Court, conducted the investigation in respect of non-cognizable offence under Section 155(2) of the Cr.P.C. Hence, the petitioners are also entitled for the very same benefit. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, issue notice before admission.

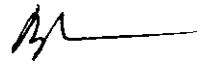
Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
