WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri. M DURGA PRASAD presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents No. 3 to 6 in harassing the petitioners and threatening to settle the dispute with the respondent No. 7 and also threatening to implicate in false criminal cases like POCSO Act is illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14, and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents Nos. 4 to 6 not to call the petitioners herein to

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the respondents police station ie., Palakeedu P.S. without following due process of law,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. M DURGA PRASAD Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 6, and also seeks time to obtain instructions/file counter, if necessary

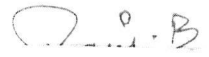
Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.7 through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that respondent Nos.3 to 6 are harassing and threatening the petitioners to settle the private disputes with respondent No.7, as they are rival parties.

The matter requires detailed examination and the said aspects can only be ascertained after filing counter-affidavit by the official respondents.

In the meanwhile, as an interim measure, the respondent Nos.1 to 6 are directed not to interfere with the *inter se* private disputes between the petitioners and respondent No.7, except in accordance with due procedure of law.
