Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of Respondent No.4 in interfering with petitioner's peaceful possession of the residential plots bearing Nos. 17 (Part) and 18, admeasuring 215 Sq. Yards (179.74 Sq. meters), and Plot No. 19, covered under Block No. 1, admeasuring 245 Sq. Yards (204.82 Sq. meters), totally admeasuring 460 Sq. Yards, situated in Survey Nos. 702/2 and 706 at Kapra Village, under Kapra Municipality, Keesara Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, as illegal, arbitrary, and without following due process of law, and consequently violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct Respondent No. 3 and 4 not to interfere with my peaceful possession and enjoyment of the said property.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.4 not to interfere with petitioner's peaceful possession and shall not take coercive steps to dispossess petitioner on the basis that the property is shown in the prohibited list i.e. Plot bearing No. 17 (Part) and 18, admeasuring 215 Sq. Yards or 179.74 Sq.mtrs, and Plot bearing No 19 covered under Block No.1 of rest of the area, admeasuring 245 Sq. Yards or 204.82 Sq.mtrs totally admeasuring 460 Sq.yds or 384.619 sq.mtrs in Survey.No. 702/2 and 706 situated at Kapra Village under Kapra Municipality, Keesara

Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, pending disposal of WP No 11475 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI K.L.B KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, SRI L. RAVINDER, AGP FOR REVENUE appearing for the Respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Status quo obtaining as on today shall be maintained in respect of the subject property bearing Plot Nos.17 (part) and 18, admeasuring 215 square yards, and Plot No.19, covered under Block No.1, admeasuring 245 square yards, total admeasuring 460 square yards in Survey Nos.702/2 and 706, situated at Kapra Village and Municipality, Keesara Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, till the next date of hearing.

Mr. L. Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for the respondents, seeks time to get instructions.
