ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.1863 of 2024 on the file of the X Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad.

2. Heard Mr.D.Rama Krishna, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.



3. When this Court is not inclined to entertain the criminal petition on the ground that specific allegations are levelled against the petitioner and the grounds raised in the criminal petition require adjudication by the trial Court, at this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner requested this Court to dispense with the presence of the petitioner/accused in C.C.No.1863 of 2024 on the ground that the petitioner is a housewife, and she will appear before the trial Court whenever her presence is specifically required.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for petitioner.

5. In view of the above submissions, the presence of the petitioner/accused in C.C.No.1863 of 2024 on the file of the X Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that she shall be represented through her counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioner is required, she shall appear before the trial Court. In case of her non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for her appearance, the



trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

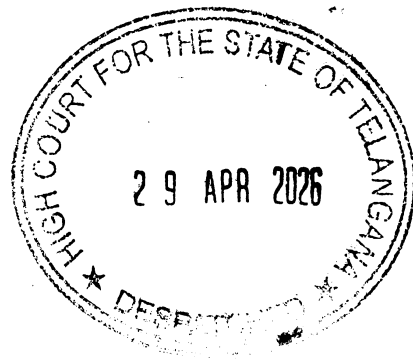
