WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri. M V HANUMANTHA RAO presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to quash the proceedings against the Petitioners in Crime No. 45 of 2026 on the file of W.P.S. South-West Zone, Hyderabad registered for the offence under section 85 of the BNS Act- 2023.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. M V HANUMANTHA RAO Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 02.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including arrest of the Petitioners No. 1 & 2 pursuant to Crime No. 45 of 2026 dated 31-03-2026, on the file of W.P.S. South-West Zone, Hyderabad registered for the offence under section 85 of the BNS Act- 2023, pending disposal of the main quash proceedings.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed the alleged offence and have been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that respondent No.2, by suppressing the existence of the earlier marriage, entered into marriage with petitioner No.1. Immediately after learning the said fact, petitioner No.1 filed F.C.O.P.No.170 of 2016 on the file of the Family Judge, City Civil Courts at Hyderabad, for seeking declaration of the marriage as null and void. In the said OP, the learned Family Court was pleased to grant injunction in I.A.No.30 of 2026, restraining the respondent No.2 from entering into residential house of petitioner No.1. It is also submitted that respondent No.2 filed complaint against her husband, Dr. Bohini Mahesh and others, which is registered as C.C.No.2082 of 2020, pending on the file of XXI Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Medchal. He further submitted that respondent No.2 filed the present complaint against the petitioners by making omnibus allegations, though the ingredients for the offence under Section 85 of the BNS are not attracted against the

petitioners. Hence, the continuation of proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 02.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 and 2 in Crime No.45 of 2026 on the file of the WPS South, West Zone, Hyderabad.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
