a.Declaring the inaction of the Respondents more particularly Respondent Nos 2 to 5 in not considering the representations dated 12/01/2026, 20/01/2026 04/03/2026 and 10/04/2026 (e-mail) and inaction of the respondents is not processing the request for extension of deputation for the 5th year in terms of the recruitment notification dt 03/11/2021 and office memorandum dtd 17/02/2016 as being arbitrary illegal bad in law and in violation of articles 14 and 350 of constitution of india.

b.Consequently direct the Respondents to process the request for extension of deputation and grant extension for the 5th year of deputation as Senior Assistant (Administration).

ORDER:

Heard Sri NSV Janaki, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Smt. PNV. Mahalakshmi, learned Standing Counsel for Central Government appearing for the respondents and perused the material on record. With their consent, this writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission itself.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is questioning the action of the respondent Nos.2 to 5 in not considering the representations of the

petitioner dated 12.01.2026, 20.01.2026, 04.03.2026 and 10.04.2026 (e-mail) and not processing the request of the petitioner for extension of deputation for the 5th year, in terms of the recruitment Notification dated 03.11.2021 and Office Memorandum dated 17.02.2016 as illegal and arbitrary and requested to direct the respondents to process the request of the petitioner for extension of deputation and grant extension for the 5th year of deputation as Senior Assistant (Administration).

3. Learned Standing Counsel for Central Government submits that the respondents will consider the representations filed by the petitioner dated 12.01.2026, 20.01.2026, 04.03.2026 and 10.04.2026 (e-mail) and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law in due course.

4. In view of the submissions made by the both sides, without going into the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to dispose of the representations filed by the petitioner dated 12.01.2026, 20.01.2026, 04.03.2026 and 10.04.2026

(e-mail) for extension of deputation of the petitioner for the 5th year, in terms of the recruitment Notification dated 03.11.2021 and Office Memorandum dated 17.02.2016, within two (2) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall stand closed.

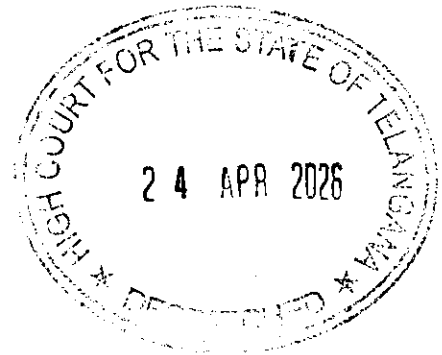
