consequently direct the respondents to take all those necessary steps as warranted and to pass appropriate proceedings re-instating the petitioner into services with all attendant benefits as per the Rules in force immediately and to grant such other relief or reliefs as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper .

Heard Sri K. Ram Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri A. Chandra Shekar, learned Standing Counsel for the respondent Nos.2 to 4.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is questioning the action of the respondents in not taking necessary steps for reinstating the petitioner into service with all attendant benefits as per law laid down by the Apex Court in catena of decisions and not considering the representations of the petitioner dated 26.07.2023 and 26.05.2025 as illegal and arbitrary and in view of the same, he requested to dispose of the writ petition by directing the

respondents to consider the said representations of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders within time frame.

3. On the other hand, learned Standing Counsel for the respondent Nos.2 to 4 submits that the respondents will consider the representations of the petitioner dated 26.07.2023 and 26.05.2025 in due course and pass appropriate orders as per law.

4. In view of the said submissions and without going into the merits of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the representations of the petitioner dated 26.07.2023 and 26.05.2025 and pass appropriate orders as per law within eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner. No order as to costs.

5. Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
