AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. B ARJUN Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

**I.A. NO: 2 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to grant stay of all further proceedings in SC.No.18 of 2026 on the file of Prl. District and Sessions Judge at Bhadradi-Kothagudem including appearance of the Petitioners/Accused No. 1 to 4 pending disposal of the above Criminal Petition.

**ORDER**

Mr.B.Arjun, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed any offences and they have been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint as well as in the final report, the ingredients for the offence under section 108 read with 62 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 are not attracted against the petitioners on the ground that the victim is alive

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners, require detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Post on 09.07.2026 along with CrI.P.No.3577 of 2026.

There shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 4 in S.C.No.18 of 2026 on the file of the Principal District and Sessions Judge, at Bhadradi-Kothagudem, for a period of eight (08) weeks.

**In default of filing proof of service by the next date of hearing, the interim stay granted shall stand vacated.**
