WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI SURESH GOUD BALASANI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the action of the Respondent authorities in not considering the representations of the petitioner dated 27.10.2025 and 30.10.2025 in requesting to cancel the mutation proceedings in favour of respondent No.5 in the revenue records with regard to Survey No. 315/59 to an extent of Ac 2.00 acres, situated in Thummaloor Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, RangaReddy District as arbitrary, illegal and unconstitutional and violation of Article 14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent authorities to consider the representations of petitioner dated 27.10.2025 and 30.10.2025 by rectifying the revenue records and enter the name of petitioner by conducting detailed enquiry with regard to Survey No. 315/59 to an extent of Ac 2.00 acres, situated in Thummaloor Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, RangaReddy District in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and Affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. SURESH GOUD BALASANI

Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
