Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the action of the Respondent authorities in not considering the representations of the petitioner dated 27.10.2025 and 30.10.2025 in requesting to cancel the mutation proceedings in favour of respondent No.5 in the revenue records with regard to Survey No. 315/59 to an extent of Ac 2.00 acres, situated in Thummaloor Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, RangaReddy District as arbitrary, illegal and unconstitutional and violation of Article 14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent authorities to consider the representations of petitioner dated 27.10.2025 and 30.10.2025 by rectifying the revenue records and enter the name of petitioner by conducting detailed enquiry with regard to Survey No. 315/59 to an extent of Ac 2.00 acres, situated in Thummaloor Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, RangaReddy District in the interest of justice.
