WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Mr. Y. BALA MURALI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction especially one in the Nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents 3 to 4, particularly the 3rd respondent to not interfere with the civil disputes while pending suit OS. No.164 of 2019 before the Prl. Senior Civil Judge at Karimnagar is illegal, arbitrary, unjust, unconstitutional, against the principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondents 3 to 4 particularly the 3rd respondent not to interfere with the civil dispute pending between the petitioner and respondents 5 to 8 without following due procedure of law and without any right and authority respondents 3 to 4, particularly the 3rd respondent to not interfere with the civil disputes while pending suit OS. No. 164 of 2019 before the Prl. Senior Civil Judge at Karimnagar without following due process of law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. Y. BALA MURALI, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to

show cause as to why this writ petition should not be admitted in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed in Writ Petition;

No. 164 of 2019 before the Prl. Senior Civil Judge at Karimnagar without following due process of law, pending disposal of Writ Petition No.13053 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Issue notice to respondent Nos.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.5 to 8 by Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service by next date of hearing.

Respondent No.4 - The Station House Officer, Kothapalli Police Station, is directed not to interfere in the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent Nos.5 to 8 without following due process of law.
